



2008 ASCE SAN DIEGO YMF STUDENT ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

The San Diego Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers, Younger Member Forum (ASCE YMF) is collecting applications for the purpose of awarding three student scholarships to UCSD and SDSU graduate and undergraduate students and community college students pursuing civil engineering or a related field. Three scholarships (totaling \$2,500) will be awarded as such:

- 1 ~ **\$1,000** scholarship awarded to a University of California San Diego (UCSD) or San Diego State University (SDSU) graduate student;
- 1 ~ **\$1,000** scholarship awarded to a UCSD or SDSU undergraduate student;
- 1 ~ **\$500** scholarship awarded to a San Diego region community college student.

ELIGIBILITY

Graduate or undergraduate students that will be enrolled in civil engineering or a related field during the 2008-2009 academic year at a recognized San Diego university or community college are eligible for this scholarship. Students graduating in Spring/Summer 2008 are not eligible. The award money is to be used for formal education expenses at the intended educational institution. *Selection will be based on interest in the field of civil engineering, educational plan, and academic performance.*

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1-page application form (attached)
- Resume to include the following (minimum):
 - Work Experience (company name, supervisor, dates/hours worked, job duties, major contributions)
 - Awards/Honors/Scholarships Received
 - Professional Organization Affiliations (i.e. ASCE, describe involvement and chair positions, if applicable)
 - Community Service/Involvement
- Letter of Recommendation (half-page, include description of relationship to you)
- Graduate Students Only – Proof of Enrollment In Graduate Program
- Essay (one-page, typed)
 - ***“Why do you deserve this scholarship? What are your plans and goals for your education and career in Civil Engineering or a related field?”***



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Review the Eligibility requirements above and the Application Criteria section for details on completing the application package
2. Prepare/Collect the following items for submission as outlined in the “Application Criteria” section:
 - a. Application Form (signed)
 - b. Resume
 - c. Letter of recommendation
 - d. Proof of enrollment in graduate program – for graduate students only
 - e. Typewritten essay
