

Unit Examination #1(100 points) Relationships, Sexuality, Pregnancy, Contraception) You are responsible for text information, class notes, film, and answers from class and group discussions.

Know how both male & female reproductive systems function. Be able to define: gonads, fallopian tubes, epididymis Cowper's gland prostate gland, urethra, glans, scrotum, semen, sperm, ovulation, menses, uterus, ovum, sperm, vasocongestion, myotonia, prostatitis, PID, gender, heterosexuality, homosexuality, bisexuality, transgender, erectile dysfunction. **Define:** zygote, embryo, fertilization, implantation, ectopic pregnancy, causes of male and female infertility, placenta, umbilicus, Braxton HIX contractions, neural tube defects, amniocentesis, and ultrasound.

How does ovulation work? What is puberty and what physical changes occur during that time in both males and females? Define a healthy relationship. How important is communication in relationships? Know the difference between healthy and unhealthy relationships, friendships, Sternberg's love triangle, jealousy, communication skills, conflict resolution, cohabitation, sexual orientating, DOMA's. What are some strategies of conflict resolution? Be able to define problems in relationships where domestic violence exists. What makes a happy marriage? What % of people divorce? Why are there so many divorces? How are children in single-parent households affected?

Know the different types of contraception and their effectiveness. Be familiar with all the advantages and disadvantages of the contraceptive methods: combination pills, minipills, Norplant, IUDs Depo Provera, patch, condoms (male & female), diaphragm, spermicides, sterilization, and vasectomy. What is Roe vs. Wade? What does the term abortion mean? What is quickening? When was abortion made legal? What is fetal viability? How does RU-486 work? Know the views of pro-choice and pro-life. There will be no questions on the actual methods of abortion. What are the reasons why a woman would terminate a pregnancy?

What are the signs of early pregnancy? Be able to define conception and where it takes place. How are twins formed? What is in-vitro fertilization? Surrogacy? What are teratogens? Why should you not smoke, drink or use drugs during pregnancy? How could teratogens harm the embryo/fetus? What STD's cause birth defects? How must a woman take care of herself during pregnancy? What illnesses can harm the embryo/fetus? What is a spontaneous abortion? What are the different stages of labor and what happens at each? What is APGAR? Why is it important for women to breastfeed? What is FAS? How much weight should a woman put on? What are the building blocks of parenting?
