Come to the library and take a look at a Bobcat, a Gopher Snake, a Red-shouldered Hawk, Tarantulas and Tarantula Hawk Wasps, a Brown Pelican and a California Gray Whale (model only, of course). Included in the display is a relief map of San Diego County.
