We look forward to our continued partnership with you as Cuyamaca College continues to seek new opportunities in promoting and expanding horticulture education. Thank you for your support.

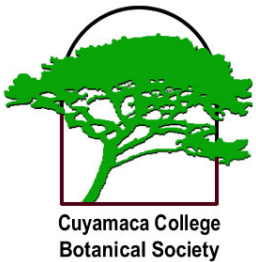
