Transfer Options

If you have to delay your transfer to SDSU for a year you may still have transfer options. *If you want to live in San Diego during the 2008-2009 academic year:* Enroll in six units at Cuyamaca College and [cross enroll](#) in one upper division general education course at SDSU. The fee is \$10 per course and you are limited to one course per semester. Make an appointment with a counselor to find out more about the cross enrollment policy at

SDSU, CSU San Marcos and UCSD. Register for additional SDSU courses through the Open University program. The Open University registration fee is \$197 per unit. Go to <http://www.ces.sdsu.edu/open.asp> for more information about the program. If your major is offered at a private university in San Diego, meet with a counselor to determine if you may be able to complete coursework at another institution and then transfer those units to SDSU.

Frequently Asked Questions

Student always inquire what is the major difference between the CSU and UC systems. The CSU grants bachelors, masters and doctorates degrees that have a practical, applied, career orientation. There are now 23 CSU campuses. The UC grants bachelors, masters, doctorates, and professional degrees. The emphasis at the bachelor's level is on theoretical learning, the assumption being that most UC graduates will pursue a higher degree before

entering their career. There are 10 UC campuses. In order to explore UCSD, SDSU, CSUSM, before transferring, students from Cuyamaca College can Cross Enroll to those schools. Cross Enrollment allows the student to enroll in courses at UCSD or SDSU without being formerly admitted while attending Cuyamaca.
