Requirements for SDSU TAG



Complete the requirements listed below by the deadlines indicated

The SDSU Transfer Admission Guarantee provides an opportunity for guaranteed admission to the university for undergraduate students transferring from SDSU service-area community colleges.

Admission to SDSU will be guaranteed for students who:

- Complete 100% of their transferable credits from institutions in SDSU's service area, including, Cuyamaca, Grossmont, Imperial Valley, San Diego City, San Diego Mesa, San Diego Miramar and Southwestern Colleges by the end of the Spring prior to admission.
- Apply for admission to SDSU via www.CSUMentor.edu during the published filing period:
- Fall application period Oct 1-November 30
- Students are **not eligible** for the Transfer Admission Guarantee in the following subjects: **School of Nursing, Music and Dance, or Television, Film and New Media, Theater Arts and Bachelor of Vocational Education.**

	Requirement	Timeline for Fall Admission
Golden Four	Complete General Education requirements in oral communication, written communication, critical thinking, and math/quantitative reasoning completed with "C" or higher grades.	Must be completed by the end of the spring term prior to fall admission
GPA	Meet the grade point average (GPA) requirement for the major or 2.4, whichever is higher listed in the SDSU General Catalog. Information can be found at www.sdsu.edu/majorgpa	Must meet the required major GPA at the time of application for admission to SDSU. This GPA must be maintained throughout the admission process.
Units	Complete a minimum of 60 transferable semester units.	Must be complete by the end of the spring term prior to fall admission
General Education	Complete a certified General Education (GE) package of 39 units (CSU GE or IGETC) or any applicable lower division GE pattern listed in the SDSU catalog.	Must be complete by the end of the spring term prior to fall admission
Major Preparation	Complete ALL of major preparation courses listed in the SDSU General Catalog. Information can be found at: www.assist.org or www.sdsu.edu/tap	Must be complete by the end of the spring term prior to fall admission

The Transfer Admission Guarantee assures admission to the university. Students must follow the rules of admission of their intended major department to be admitted into the major. The Students must plan to take any required course not offered by their institution at another local community college or through SDSU Cross Enrollment. Attendance at local community colleges will be verified by the National Clearinghouse. Therefore, students who misrepresent institution attendance will have their admission revoked. Students who are not eligible for the Transfer Admission Guarantee will be ranked based on the extent to which they have completed the requirements listed above. SDSU will admit via this ranking until all available enrollment slots have been filled.
