








# Table 17. Cuyamaca First-Time Students Annual Persistence Rates Disaggregated by Gender



### Figure 3. African American/Black Student Annual Persistence


### Figure 4. Hispanic/Latinx Student Annual Persistence

### Figure 6. Pacific Islander Student Annual Persistence






Figure 7. Student Annual and Term Persistence







### Figure 8. African American/Black Student Term Persistence


### Figure 9. Hispanic/Latinx Student Term Persistence







### Figure 10. Native American Student Term Persistence

### Figure 11. Pacific Islander Student Term Persistence






Figure 14. Cuyamaca College 3-Year Graduation Rates for First-Time, Full-Time Students
