A standard, lecture-oriented classroom can meaningfully be converted to an "active learning laboratory" by changing out the single-chair desks to multiple-chair round tables. This Active Learning Laboratory is modeled after Technology Enabled Active Learning Laboratory (for example, see https://it.ucmerced.edu/teal). In lieu of a TEAL Lab, which would require far more planning and resources, an AL Lab can being the process of demonstrating how such rooms can be functionally utilize for the benefit of student learning and outcomes.

Dr. Franco, prior to being hired at Cuyamaca College, pioneered the utilization of UC Merced's Technology Enabled Active Learning (TEAL) Laboratory. After undergoing training, he used this space for five courses over 3 different semesters. Based on student evaluations and pre-test/post-test surveys, he found that students appreciated the physical structure of the TEAL Lab because it allowed for seamless transitions between large-class lecturing to small-group discussions and collaborations.
