The addition of a full time, tenure-track faculty member to the Ornamental Horticulture program would benefit OH students and the college's organizational health through the provision of a more consistent and dedicated leadership for the program over time. The current ratio of full time to part time faculty is 1:17. The recent, and sudden, change in OH program coordinators (2018) was disruptive to the program's function, and increased the workload for college administrative faculty and staff as a result. This type of disruptive leadership transition could be prevented by re-filling the existing second OH full time faculty position.

The addition of a full time, tenure-track faculty member to the Ornamental Horticulture program aids the college's organizational health through the provision of a more consistent and dedicated leadership for the program over time. The addition of a full time, tenure-track faculty member to the Ornamental Horticulture program would benefit OH students through a more consistent presentation of content from a dedicated instructor. While a diverse adjunct faculty provides different perspectives and exposure to a variety of industry-related experience, the benefit of a full time faculty member, dedicated to the OH program's success over time exceeds that.

The vacancy in this existing position impacts delivery of curriculum to students, as well as future planning for the OH program. It should be noted that Southwestern College is adding a second full time faculty member to their Landscape & Nursery Technology program. A diminished faculty at OH will continue or exacerbate the transfer of OH's students from Cuyamaca College to Southwestern College.
