Since the last program review, I (Keenan Murray) have taken over the Surveying Coordinator position for Pat Newman. Hence, I will be using this annual review as a chance to get to know the program better. I will use last years' program review as an initial template of topics and goals to review.

- Last year, we reported nearly a doubling of the number of students enrolled in SURV. This year, the numbers has returned to 2019 numbers of 18 students reported for SP21. However, the percentage of women enrolled has still increased from 2019, from 6% to 17% (2019 - 1 female student; 2021 – 3 female students)
- The local chapter of California Lan Surveyors Association continue to support the program but has not donated any new equipment over the past year.
- At Cuyamaca, the Survey classes are vital to those Engineering students wishing to be Civil Engineers. The Engineering program educates the Surveying students in some aspects of their profession. It is a symbiotic relationship. It works the same way in the job market. In the industry, the Surveying community relies upon Cuyamaca College to keep supplying surveyors through its surveying classes. The next closest program is Mt. San Jacinto – Riverside.

II.B.1. What progress has been made in your program to address the institutional goals set around student success and equity? {2019 Equity Plan} If qualitative or quantitative data is available, please summarize any findings.

The SURV program is predominantly serving the white population, with 61% of or students identifying as white compared to 35% of student's campus-wide identifying as white. While a large gap still exists between the SURV program and the campus-wide statistic, the SURV program student population is more diverse compared to 2018 and 2019, when 80% and 67% of SURV students identified as white. I am unaware of any currently active measures in place for the SURV program to actively diversify the student pool and could be a good goal for the program to focus on!

Because the number of enrolled students is lower, the equity gap data on a per semester bases does not typically identify equity gaps in our program because as a minimum of 10 enrolled students for a specific group is required. However, over the past 5 years, an equity gap was identified for Hispanic students, as they had a 79% and 76% retention and success rate compared to the White students who had a 95% and 89% retention and success rate over the past 5 years. Hence, it appears that the Hispanic students who we retain are successful, but we should find a way to increase the retention of our Hispanic students.

II.B.2. In light of the goals set in your program review, what are your plans to improve equitable student outcomes (success, retention, persistence, graduation, etc.) in the coming year?

As noted in last year's review, the program is currently run by part-time faculty members who are also full-time professionals in the surveying field. They are engaged with our students, provide extracurricular presentations, and even sometimes help students acquire jobs or internships after completing one course. However, if we are going to try to fill equity gaps in our smaller program, we will need to create a plan that incorporates myself (the surveying coordinator) and college-wide support and services as it is not reasonable to expect these part-time instructors/full-time professionals to donate more of their time. I will need to come up with a plan!

While our retention and success rates did not drop very much compared to the campus-wide population, the SURV program is a very hands-on equipment/software program. The professionals teaching our courses did the best they could do, but they were very much in agreement that these courses should remain in-person due to the hands-on requirements for the courses.

Because our professional instructors typically teach on the weekends, and work during the week, we will need double the equipment to fit our professional's careers. So, for the next year I will work with our Dean to review our supply budget for maintaining our equipment and determine what potential pathways we could use to acquire more equipment for the possibility of offering two sections of SURV-218 a semester.
