

Career Center Demographics (December 2021)

Data Sources and Parameters

The Career Center provided a list of students who received their services in the 2020-2021 academic year. Demographic data (i.e., gender and race/ethnicity) were accessed using the GCCCD Information System. Cuyamaca College student population data for the 2020-2021 academic year are provided as a reference point and comparison for students who received Career Center services, and to examine access to services through an equity lens.

Summary of Results

 Hispanic/Latinx students were underrepresented in receiving services from the Career Center when compared to the Cuyamaca College student population. Middle Eastern students and White students were overrepresented in receiving services when compared to the Cuyamaca College student population.
