

Personal Counseling Student Demographics (December 2021)

Data Sources and Parameters

Personal Counseling provided a list of students who received their services in the 2020-2021 academic year. Demographic data (i.e., gender and ethnicity) were accessed using the GCCCD Information System. Cuyamaca College student population data for the 2020-2021 academic year are provided as a reference point and comparison for students who received personal counseling services and to examine access to services through an equity lens.

Summary of Results

• Hispanic/Latinx students were overrepresented in receiving services from Personal Counseling when compared to the Cuyamaca College student population.
