- a. According to Fall 2022 enrollment data, women were underrepresented by 1% and men overrepresented by 1%. African-American and Hispanic/Latino were overrepresented by 5% and 6%, respectively. Students <20 years old were overrepresented by 18%. According to Retention and Success data, there were no demographic equity gaps in Fall 2022.
- b. According to Spring 2023 enrollment data, women were underrepresented by 10% and men overrepresented by 9%. African-American, Hispanic/Latino, and Middle Eastern/North African were overrepresented by 5%, 1%, and 11%, respectively. Students <20 years old were overrepresented by 11%. According to Retention and Success data, Hispanic/Latino, Middle Eastern/North African experienced an equity gap.

13. What challenges is your program still experiencing due to the disruption of operations caused by the pandemic and the need to offer services in various modalities?

- a. The POSC Program is suffering from a lack of sections. POSC voluntarily reduced the number of sections we offered from 10 sections to 5 sections, in concern of potential worsening budget outlook. However, other disciplines did not take the same approach. Furthermore, POSC is one of dozen+ disciplines campuswide that offer a dual enrollment course off campus, one of a few with the Behavioral and Social Sciences Department. As we claw out of the pandemic, the POSC program should be indemnified by restoring sections and other disciplines should be invited to offer dual enrollment courses.

a. All POSC courses for summer 2020, fall 2020, spring 2021, fall 2021, spring 2022, and fall 2022 have been taught online, so there is no difference between modalities. In Spring 2023, POSC were finally offered face-to-face. Retention and success was 98% and 89% for face-to-face courses, and 75% and 63% for online courses, a noticable gap. The POSC program will strategize on what is accounting for the gap and develop a plan of action during AY2023-24.
