In recent years, these gaps have been eliminated. Both spring and fall terms, equity gaps in success rates were consistent for students of multiple races/ethnicities.

The program is committed to hiring instructors that represent the Kumeyaay people and culture and preserving the Kumeyaay culture. San Diego County includes 12 Kumeyaay reservations, which include vastly underserved Indigenous students. This program also focuses on preserving and restoring Kumeyaay language, which at present is considered critically endangered, with only 31 speakers left. This program will reverse that trend by revitalizing the language and culture and providing opportunities for local Indigenous students to have greater access and a strong sense of community in college.

The students continued working on the Kumeyaay village and hosted event that promote awareness through interactive activities and classes, while also collaborating with other groups and departments.

The pandemic did present a challenging situation that required faculty to learn to teach online and ultimately stronger, more robust courses and the ability to deliver in the online teaching modality to outlying areas that were previously not well served. Information gathered through the struggle to transition to online resulted in improved courses, student learning, and access to Kumeyaay Studies courses online from anywhere.
