Hi Jessica,

Yes, I've been looking into this and trying to find a secure place to store the tools for the village (I was able to purchase some tools over the summer and they already had a good amount). The complications are that students will need to be able to access the space, and during the weekends and after hours.

Francisco and I have been talking about this. A concern is giving students access to locked spaces on campus.

Earlier this week I reached out to Amy Huie about having the tools stored, at least temporarily in the OH overflow area (near the pantry and CDC). She is supportive of that, but wants to connect with Stan about how/where to store the tools in that space, which we can certainly do (some tule boats are already being stored there)

Longer term, I'm thinking that what makes the most sense is to install some kind of tool shed in the village and garden area. I was out there on Wednesday during the Humanities class and we discussed this. A tool shed right there seemed most ideal to everyone.

I might have the budget to just purchase a small tool shed. But it would of course need to be installed.
