The engineering supply budget is \$3,000 while other fields of STEM have supply budgets of \$6,036-\$51,979. Additionally, our engineering budget is significantly lower than other engineering programs while, simultaneously, we are the second largest feeder of transfer engineering students to SDSU. We want to continue to be innovative in our course content to encourage student enrollment and engagement and expand our course offerings to provide articulated pathways for our students. Hence, we are asking for financial backing of our endeavors. We hypothesized implementing project-based learning and hands-on experiences would help us close enrollment and success equity gaps. Over the past few years, we have closed our race/ethnicity access equity gaps and want to continue our work to close our success equity gaps. With our development of project-based curriculum, our supply budget has become very restrictive. For instance, our new Full-time Faculty, Carlos Perez, wanted to purchase electrical engineering supplies valued over \$6,000 to implement projects in each of his courses and we had to tell him we could only fund a portion of his requests. We have also been running our 5 3D printers for a total print time of 341 days the past semester. This increase of use is resulting in worn/damaged print surfaces/plates and the need to replace the hot ends (the part where the printing material comes out). If we plan and prepare to replace the 3D printers' build surfaces 3 times a year, the build plate once a year, and the hot end once a year, the cost is approximately \$400 a year. For 5 3D printers, that is \$2,000.

Goal 1: Increase student success in sophomore-level engineering courses through increased support for ENGR 100 and all other lab classes

Goal 2: Create Maker Space to support labs, student projects, engineering club, and national competition teams

Our 3D printers are used extensively in our ENGR 100 Introduction to Engineering & Design course for projects such as derby car races, reproduction of historical structures, and designing cell phone holders. We hypothesized that project-based learning and handson experiences in the first engineering course would help us engage students and provide them with the knowledge and confidence to be successful in future engineering courses. We believe these projects are part of the reason behind our success in closing access equity gaps, but we still have significant work to improve our success equity gaps. Hence, we are asking for a supply budget augmentation to cover the cost of maintenance/repair of the 3D printers and allow us to further implement project-based learning and hands-on curriculum in our program.
