
Q1 How did you first learn about the commencement ceremony?





Q3 Did you experience the entire Commencement Ceremony?









So either provide water or make sure to let us know to bring our own water. The water fountains upstairs by the restrooms were not working at all. I finally found a working fountain downstairs before we went out the door to the ceremony, but I could have used more water. Also, more control over the crowd would have been great with regard to the honor line. The honor line worked great until you got to the end. People were crowded around the end of the line to greet their graduate, but in the process totally blocked any way for the rest of us to get out to find your own family and friends. I literally had to push may way through the crowd to try to get away from the crowd to locate my own friends and family. It took 10 to 15 minutes before we found each other via phone texts trying to figure out where they were located. They ended up going to the parking lot on the other side of the black fence to wait for me. Finally we got together. The families need to be kept off to the sides away from the only way that we are funneled out from the ceremony. It was just one huge traffic jam of people and no one was moving and we were trapped by the fence at the back with no where to go except to the left or to the right which was extremely difficult to even move.
