## Cuyamaca English as a Second Language (ESL)

Comparison of Traditional and New ESL Pathways: Transfer-Level English Completion in One and Five Years

Cuyamaca College began offering ESL-1A and ESL-2A in Fall 2016. These courses are part of an accordion model that shortens the ESL sequence to transfer-level English. This report compares the ESL-1A students' completion of transfer-level English (ENGL-120) within <u>one</u> year to ESL-096 and ESL-100 students' completion of transfer-level English within <u>five</u> years. Overall, the one-year throughput rate for ESL-1A students is greater than the five-year throughput rate for ESL-096 students. Additionally, the one-year throughput rate for ESL-1A students is similar to the five-year throughput rates for ESL-100 students.

This report also compares the ESL-2A students' completion of transfer-level English within one year to ESL-106 students' completion of transfer-level English within five years. Although the five-year throughput rate for the ESL-106 students is greater than the one-year throughput rate for ESL-2A students, the <u>numbers</u> of ESL-106 and ESL-2A students completing transfer-level English in these different time frames are similar.

The following tables reflect the transfer-level English completion rates at Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (GCCCD) for students who attempted ESL-1A, ESL-096, ESL-100, ESL-2A, or ESL-106 at Cuyamaca College.

Overall, the one-year throughput rate for ESL-1A students (24%) is greater than the five-year throughput rate for ESL-096 students (17%). Additionally, the one-year throughput rate for ESL-1A students (24%) is similar to the five-year throughput rates for ESL-100 students (23%).

Although the five-year throughput rate for the ESL-106 students (58%) is greater than the one-year throughput rate for ESL-2A students (48%), the number of ESL-106 and ESL-2A students completing transferlevel English in these different time frames is comparable (74 and 71 students, respectively).
