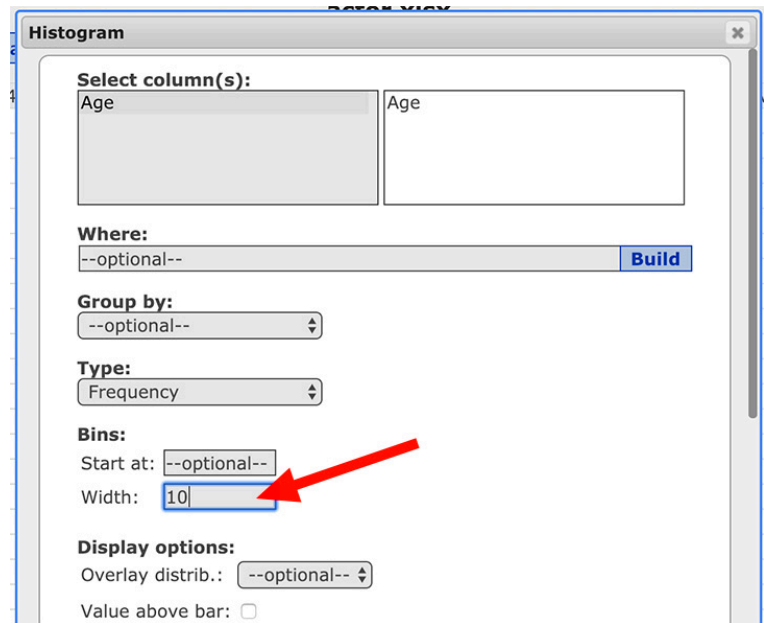


ADJUST HISTOGRAM BIN WIDTH

To change the bin width of a histogram:

- 1) Select **Graph**→**Histogram**
- 2) If necessary, move the appropriate variable to the **Select column(s)** box on the left.
- 3) Enter a new width in the **Bins: Width:** textbox.

Then click **Compute** in the bottom right corner of the Histogram dialogue box.
