Step 1

CREATE AN OPENCCC ACCOUNT

- Check this box if you do not have a Social Security Number. International students, nonresident aliens, and other [exceptions](#), may not.




Step 3

- Some students may not have any of the listed documents & that's OK, you can still apply!
- If this is the case, select "Other" from the drop down box and then check the "No Documents" box when completing the application. Your information will remain confidential.
- *Note: If you select "No Documents", you may be required to provide additional information later. You may also be eligible for an AB 2364 high school tuition exemption.
- If you are a former or current military dependent, please make sure to indicate so.
