

# 60 UNITS +

Certificates of Specialization and Certificates of Achievement allow you to enhance your skills within a particular job or career. You only need to complete major courses to obtain these certificates--no general education is needed. Certificates generally can take 1 to 2 semesters to complete. Associate of Science Degrees and Associate of Arts Degrees typically take two or more years to complete. These require both major and general education courses, as well as completing 60 degree-applicable units. It can take two or more years to complete courses needed to transfer to a public California university. Transferring to a public California university requires both major preparation and general education courses, as well as completing 60 transferable units.
