Resolved, that the District, Cuyamaca College and Grossmont College Classified Senates advocate for an official and public proclamation of remaining in emergency remote mode for Spring 2021, as soon as possible;

Resolved, that the District, Cuyamaca College and Grossmont College Classified Senates advocate for the formation of teams with significant representation of faculty and classified professionals, the purpose of which is to determine and implement ways to work successfully in a remote capacity.
