# RATIONALE FOR SELECTING TRAINING ASSISTANT FOR TEACHING & LEARNING/PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Supported by the faculty PD coordinator role and was implemented as a Flex Coordinator and Vision Resource Center administrator; however, this was not aligned with faculty responsibilities. Responsibility was then supported through one time and grant funds.
- Flex programming and hours reporting is the responsibility of the College, as it is not centralized in the district. Grossmont College has a full-time Training Assistant to support the implementation of their PD programing; no comparable position currently exists at Cuyamaca.
- PD plays a central role in our strategic and equity plans and is codified in our accreditation standards and Title 5. This position is required to ensure compliance with faculty professional development processes, policies, and reporting as well as to support college-wide professional development program implementation.
