Status Update

- Eligibility for Growth Funding
 - On track to receive growth funding in 2025-2026 and 2026-2027, if available
 - A 9% increase in supplemental outcomes (FA)
- Institutionalizing the Community Engagement Project
 - Community Engagement Project (now Pathways for Adult to Career Training)
 - \$655M federal appropriation to expand
- Exploring a New Student System
 - Team has been meeting with Workday
 - Engaging with Workday on creating a pathway to full engagement

- **Stability and Consistency in Procedures and Processes (HR)**
 - New leadership has made significant strides in documentation and communication processes
 - Updating policies and procedures
 - Updating forms
 - Working on institutionalizing mandatory training

- **Pursuing a Bond Measure in 2026**
 - Poll/survey conducted in November
 - Moderately favorable
 - Need to increase awareness of our needs
 - Community awareness campaign in process

- **Implementing a Centralized Facilities Unit**
 - New AVC on board
 - Working on organizational structure
 - Centralizing maintenance with a focus on preventable maintenance

- **Rebuilding and restructuring District Services**
 - Campus safety has been primary focus
 - Current structure not working
 - Gathering input
 - Examining other models (Southwestern, SDCCD)

Current focus is to restructure CAPs as an intermediate step
