II. Announcements

A. Academic Senate Annual Fundraiser Update (Link): Rachel Jacob-Almeida informed the senate that the Cuyamaca College Academic Senate's annual fundraiser currently has \$205 out of the \$1400 goal. The money from this fundraiser goes towards paying for faculty awards and helps support faculty throughout the year.
