<p>F3: Images and Representation Images and representations are diverse, and/or the instructor acknowledges the lack of diversity and provides a platform for discussion around representations and stereotypes</p>	
<p>F4: Human Interaction Bias Human biases are acknowledged, and there is information about mitigating, addressing, and handling bias in the class.</p>	
<p>F5: Content Meaning At least three course activities require students to connect course content to their own lives and/or reflect on course content in relation to a variety of perspectives.</p>	

F6: Personal Connections with and among students At least three course activities require students to interact with each other in ways that value diverse student experiences and perspectives.	
F7: Universal Design for Learning (ULD) Course content and activities are aligned with core principles of UDL--i.e., multiple means of representation, action & expression, and/or engagement.	
F8: Student Support Syllabus outlines student support & well-being services in, at least, these areas: a) general student assistance, b) online academic supports; c) assistance with using technology; d) health and well-being resources; and/or e) resources for students with disabilities
