Two scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to students who are either newly enrolled, currently attending, or enrolling in any accredited college, community college, or trade school with a program related to water management, treatment, technology, or a similar field.

Application Deadline: July 31, 2026

Scholarship Requirements – To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- **Residency:** Must reside within the Sweetwater Authority service area.
- **Education:** Must be currently enrolled in a college, university, or accredited vocational program.
- **Essay:** Submit a 1–2 page essay (typed, double-spaced) addressing the prompt: "How will your academic background support your goals within the water industry?"
- **Letter of Recommendation:** Include one signed letter of recommendation from a professor, advisor, employer, or community leader familiar with your academic or professional background.
- **Transcript:** Unofficial transcripts may be requested to verify enrollment and coursework relevant to your goals.
