Financial Education Project Goals

- System-wide
- Tying things together: Identifying the cross-walks
- Specific Financial Education (FE) goals:
 - Increase financial competency of all students
 - Increase Student Success
 - Reduce Loan default (see it's third on the list!)
 - Creating Institution-wide Effort

Phase One

- Its All About "Integrative" Dissemination of Financial Education on your Campus
- Establishing FE Team
 - Leadership
 - Members
- Role
 - Create, Manage and Tracking Financial Education initiative
 - Identifying institutional opportunities and/or partners
 - Establish collaboration with Student Success Effort
 - Establish collaboration with Default Prevention EffortWhere applicable
 - o Timeline: Beginning Fall 2014 and continuing

Phase One

- Making FE a part of important campus activities
- Review list of enrollment cycle opportunities listed in template.
- Choose select opportunities with goal of increasing list as opportunities arise in normal course of academic year
- Find partner associated with that activities and explain goal of disseminating FE material on that occasion
- Choose material from Tool Kit and provide that to Partner/Collaborator for dissemination
- Record this in your plan: Who, what, when, how, and mechanism for reporting back to Team that task was completed

Phase One

- Making FE a routine part of campus operations
- Finding Campus partners to disseminate FE materials
 - Review Template for partial list of campus partners.
 You are not limited this list
- Meet face-to-face
- Explain goal of disseminating FE information through 'any and all' routine interactions with students
- Explore what they do and how, looking for ideas about how they may be able to disseminate FE 'routinely'
- Together review Tool Kit. Let them choose one or more things they think appropriate
- Establish an implementation plan: Who, what, when, how, and mechanism for reporting back to Team on progress

Phase One

- Collaboration with student success team
 - Establish Meeting with Student Success team
 - Review current student success initiatives
 - Explore how to integrate FE materials and activities into current student success effort
 - Review CashCourse and Tool Kit to match resources with opportunities
 - Written...even if brief...implementation plan to be made part of school FE plan

Phase One

- Collaboration with default prevention team
 - Establish Meeting with DP team or individuals charged with default prevention (if there are any)
 - Review Current Default Prevention Activities
 - Discuss how to integrate FE materials and activities into current default prevention effort
 - Review CashCourse and Tool Kit to match resources with opportunities
 - Written...even if brief...implementation plan to be made part of school FE plan

Phase Two

- Integrating FE onto campuses
 - This is where the effort separates from the usual...
- Classroom/Workshop/Special Initiatives
- Training CC system and school staff to become FE trainers
 - Process
 - o Identify system-level and school-level volunteers
 - Training
 - Certification

Phase Two


- Training Materials
- CCCCO will establish curriculum team
 - Development of 'turn-key' materials that schools can use in classroom, workshops, special initiatives
 - Available to all schools
- Material will be added to toolkit...more to come
- o Timeline: 11/2014 12/2015
- All schools can participate
 - Level of participation...your choice

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Phase Three

- External FE Efforts
 - Utilizing new FE capacity to benefit your local community
 - FE for Secondary Schools in your CC district
 - FE in your local community
- Timeline
 - Initiate once Phases one and Phase two are fully implemented (2016-17)
 - Identify community partners/partnerships
 - CCCCO curriculum team will develop FE training materials
 - Community FE materials to be added to toolkit
- Most Important: Don't give it a second thought right now
