Terms of the Scholarship and Disbursement Process:

- 1. Recipients must have a VALID direct contact information for the Financial Aid and Scholarship Office to maintain contact with them for the Academic year.
- 2. Recipients must be enrolled in at least **9 units** for <u>each semester</u> (Fall 2022 and Spring 2023) <u>at Cuyamaca</u> College and maintain a minimum 2.0 overall grade point average.
- 3. The Cuyamaca College Scholarship Specialist will verify enrollment on Census Day of each semester.
- 4. After enrollment is verified, funds will be disbursed per the scholarship disbursement process. The student will receive \$375 each semester for a total of \$750 for the academic year.
- 5. In the event a selected recipient fails to enroll in a minimum of 9 units for the Fall and/or Spring semester(s) the award will be forfeited. The alternate recipient will then be awarded the remaining amount to be disbursed "IF" the alternate meets the terms outlined above.
