University of Redlands Information:

- Completion of the articulated courses is **optional** prior to transfer and can be completed at University of Redlands if not completed at Cuyamaca College.
- University of Redlands admission requirements to the undergraduate Business programs are: 40 transferable credits, minimum 2.0 GPA and 3 years full time work experience.
- The School of Business will offer Cuyamaca College students a 10% tuition discount for classes attended at School of Business facilities provided they meet all admission requirements, student accounts remain current and the student matriculates directly from a California Community College, transferring in at least 21 credits earned at Cuyamaca College.
