

## VA News

On June 1, 2022, COVID -19 legislation that permits students receiving a Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA) at the resident (in person) rate, while taking courses converted to online training due to COVID-19 will end.

### How will this affect me?

To continue receiving MHA at the resident rate, students must enroll in at least one course that is offered in-person. Otherwise, they will receive the online rate, which is half the national average, beginning June 2, 2022.


### Student Pantry


## School Supplies

## COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATES

VA Health Care facilities are currently administering COVID-19 vaccination for the following groups:

- VA health care personnel
- Veterans living in VA long-term facilities
- Veterans who receive care at VA and are at high risk for COVID-19 based on VA and CDC [risk criteria](#)
- Veterans who are at least 75 years of age
- Caregivers of veterans, if the veteran is eligible for the vaccine







# VA EDUCATION BENEFIT PAPERWORK

Submit **ALL** of the following paperwork to Debra Ayers, via email at [debra.ayers@gcccd.edu](mailto:debra.ayers@gcccd.edu), or in-person. To certify your enrollment for the summer 2022 semester:

- [Semester Worksheet](#)
- [Grossmont College Guest Intent Form](#) (if you are also taking classes at Grossmont this semester).
- If you have changed your major, you will need to provide a One Semester Educational Plan or a new Comprehensive Educational Plan. The educational plan must be submitted with the semester worksheet. If you are a continuing student and have not submitted a Comprehensive Educational Plan you will need to provide a copy before enrollment will be certified to the VA.
- The One Semester Educational Plan can be created and obtained during drop-in appointments. The Comprehensive Educational Plan can be created and obtained during a 60 minute appointment. Click [here](#) to sign up for a Virtual Drop-In.
