HOW TO PREPARE FOR A JOB FAIR

EMPLOYERS WANT TO KNOW...

Who are you? What do you do?

Why should they care?

How can you help their business?

What do you want from this interaction?



DO

Get your resume reviewed at the Career Center

Review attending companies and research them

Dress professionally

Have several copies of your resume

Smile, give a firm handshake, make eye contact

Stand and sit up straight

Make yourself memorable in a positive way

Listen carefully to what they have to say

Ask for a business card or write down their info

Ask thoughtful questions such as:

- *What goals does your company have for the future?*
- *What kinds of entry level positions are available?*
- *What made you choose to work for this company?*
- *What are some of the skills you look for in candidates?*

Follow up with them within 24-48 hours:

- *Send a thank you note including where you met and your interest in learning more about the company and opportunities*
- *Send them a personalized connection request on LinkedIn*
- *Follow the company on LinkedIn*
- *Connect with your Career Center for guidance on establishing a meaningful connection with the company*



DON'T

Forget to deliver your elevator pitch

Drop a resume on their table and walk off

Text or take calls in front of recruiters

Say that you just need any job

Just grab freebies from their table

Waste the opportunity practice networking

Be negative about your previous employer

Be shy or expect that they will approach you

Interrupt them when they're talking to others

Pester them with an influx of emails/calls

Ask questions such as:

- *What is the pay? (Don't bring up wages in this setting. The goal is to show interest and get a potential interview.)*
- *What about benefits and vacation time? (This is usually discussed when the hiring manager offers you the job.)*
- *What does your company do? (Research beforehand. However, it is okay to ask if they are a small company or outside of your industry or region.)*
