ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS			
<p>Cuyamaca College will confer the Degree of Associate in Science or Associate in Arts upon students who successfully complete the following requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A minimum of 60 semester units of degree applicable courses. The 60 units include a minimum of 18 units in a specified major plus completion of one of the General Education plans available. 2. Achievement of a "C" average (2.0 GPA) in all college work counted toward general education requirements. 3. Achievement of a "C" grade or better or a "P"¹ in all courses counted towards a major requirement. 4. A maximum of 12 "P"¹ semester units taken in regular course work at this institution may be counted toward the 60 semester units required for graduation. 5. Residency: Students that have met all graduation requirements may obtain their degree from Cuyamaca College if they are currently enrolled and have satisfactorily completed at least 12 degree applicable semester units of approved course work in the district. 6.
