Important Information

- Courses must be completed with a “C” grade or higher and carry a minimum of 3 semester units. Grades of “C-” are not acceptable. A grade of “P” in approved coursework at GCCCD is acceptable for certification. Some CSU and UC campuses may have limitations on the number of P/NP units that may be used to meet degree requirements.
- Courses may be listed in more than one area but will not be certified in more than one area.
- Courses must be approved for Cal-GETC during the academic year they are taken. Approvals may differ between Cuyamaca and Grossmont Colleges.
- Upon full completion of Cal-GETC, students must request certification from the Admissions and Records office if required by the transfer institution.
