Students transferring to the University of California are required to demonstrate competence (proficiency) in a language other than English equal to two years of high school study. Competence may also be satisfied through: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Completion of two years of the same foreign language in high school with grades of “C-” or better;</li> <li>• Satisfactory completion, with C grades or better, of two years of formal schooling at the sixth grade level or higher in an institution where the language of instruction is not English. The appropriate documentation must be presented to the evaluation office to substantiate that the required coursework was completed. Students who cannot provide such documentation should either pass one of the examinations or tests listed below, or satisfactorily complete an appropriate college level language course.</li> <li>• Satisfactory score on the SAT II: Subject Test in languages other than English. See evaluator or Articulation Officer for necessary scores.</li> <li>• Satisfactory score, 3 or higher, in the College Board Advanced Placement Examinations in languages other than English.</li> <li>• Satisfactory score, 5 or higher, in the International Baccalaureate Higher Level Examinations in language other than English.</li> <li>• Satisfactory completion of an achievement test administered by a community college, university, or other college in a language other than English. The test must assess the student’s proficiency at the level equivalent to two year of high school language. This conclusion must be posted on a transcript indicating unit, course title and grade or on a document with letterhead of the institution granting proficiency.</li> <li>• If an achievement test is not available, a faculty member associated with a US regionally accredited institution of higher education can verify a student’s competency. The institution must provide a document on letterhead asserting that the student has mastered proficiency in the language equivalent to two years of high school study.</li> <li>• Language other than English “O” level exam with grade of “A,” “B” or “C.”</li> <li>• Language other than English International “A” Level exam with a score of 5, 6, or 7.</li> <li>• A Defense Language Institute language other than English course which is indicated as passed with a “C” or higher on the official transcript.</li> </ul>
