## **CLOSE CONTACT DEFINED:**

- WERE WITHIN 6-FEET OF A COVID 19 POSITIVE INDIVIDUAL FOR A CUMULATIVE TOTAL OF 15 MINUTES OR MORE OVER A 24 HOUR PERIOD.
- HAD UNPROTECTED CONTACT WITH THE BODY FLUIDS OR SECRETIONS OF A POSITIVE COVID 19 INDIVIDUAL (COUGHED ON, SNEEZED ON SHARING UTENSILS, DRINKING OUT OF SAME CONTAINER.)

## **COVID-19 SYMPTOMS:**

FEVER, CHILLS, SORE THROAT, COUGH, RUNNY NOSE, FATIGUE, BODY ACHES, HEADACHE, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, LOSS OF TASTE OR SMELL, NAUSEA, VOMITING, DIARRHEA SEND STUDENT HOME

- Guidance is based on "Up to Date" vaccine status versus "Not Up to Date Vaccine status.
- All "Not Up to Date" individuals will be asked to quarantine for 5-days from the date of onset of exposure, to include a Covid-19 PCR/Antigen Test on or after day 5 of exposure. If testing negative may emerge from quarantine.
- All "Up to Date" individuals need not formally quarantine; however, take a Covid-19 PCR/Antigen Test on or after day 5 of exposure.
