FACULTY:

Student Health Services RN will ensure that student is tested for Covid 19 (antigen/PCR.) San Diego Public Health Case Investigators will provide guidance based on asymptomatic status or symptomatic status for start date of isolation.

Typically five days to start from date of symptom onset or testing date.

All Guidance from SDPH is from the "Order of the Health Officer."

- Guidance will be based on symptomatic versus asymptomatic status of the individual
- All guidance will be provided to the student via phone when available and confirmed by email
- Once the student repeats the Covid 19 testing if they choose after day five of isolation and they are deemed negative with no further symptoms, they will get a clearance letter by the Health Services RN, that they are clear for campus classes.
- Note the student must be cleared by a Student Health Services RN to return to on campus classes and will receive a clearance letter as proof



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
