

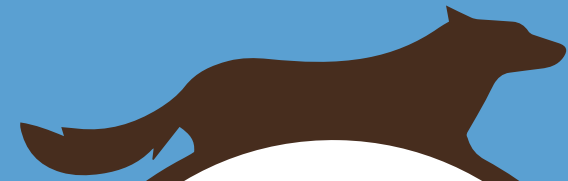

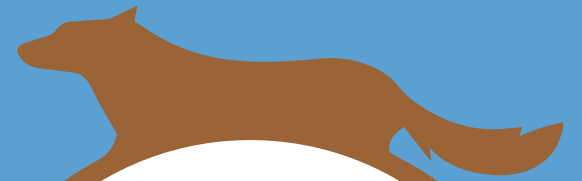

Middle Eastern Heritage Month

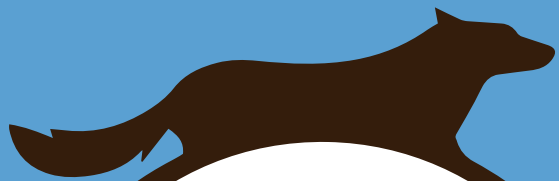
During Middle Eastern Heritage Month (April), we celebrate the cultures, contributions, history, and resilience of Middle Eastern communities.

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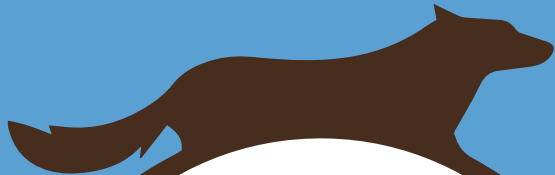
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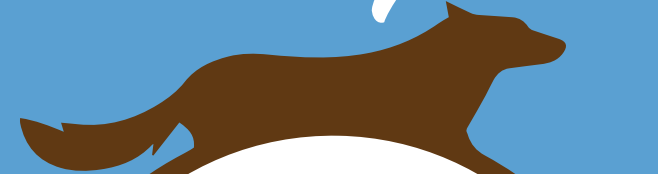
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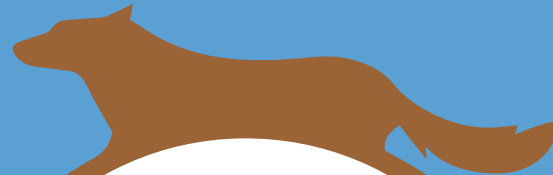
