

How to Read Bills on Congress.gov

Each bill gets a number. H.R. designates a bill that originated in the house. S. designates a bill that originated in the senate.

When a bill becomes law, it gets a different number: most laws get public law numbers, but some get private law numbers. It's always two numbers. In this example, 116 represents the 116th congress, while the 341 represents the 341st law that this congress passed.
